EXPAND YOUR CAREER

Multnomah Education Service District (MESD) and George Fox University (GFU) College of Education are partnering to bring you a 15-18 month program that is designed to eliminate barriers, reduce costs and expand your career opportunities. The TSPC Principal License is the required first license for all administrators to serve at either the building or district level. Classes start virtually on September 6, 2022 and continue through spring semester 2024.

A PROGRAM DESIGNED FOR YOU

This program is designed to serve a wide variety of working adult learners:

- Candidates with a Master's degree or those who want to earn an MEd in Educational Leadership
- Candidates working in leadership roles with no previous TSPC license (note on application)
- Candidates currently in an ESD and/or School District role as Administrators-TOSAs, Classroom Teachers, Counselors or Other School Personnel
- Online coursework with the flexibility to meet virtually and/or face-to-face at an MESD location as the cohort determines

Scholarship opportunities are available from the Oregon Administrator Scholars Program (OASP), which could *fully cover the cost of your license*. OASP awards up to a maximum of \$10,000 per academic year for racially or linguistically diverse administrator candidates enrolled in a license program. The scholarships may be used to pay for classes, fees and related costs.

CURRICULUM

Our course content is rooted within shared professional context and regional initiatives, and is developed in collaboration with MESD adjunct instructors and full-time GFU Educational Leadership faculty. A portion (21) of the Principal License program credits and 28 total credits, including the Professional Administrator License Program, are transferable into the GFU's Doctorate in Educational Leadership (EdD) 56-credit program upon request.
